Short description of the project, including its aims	The immigration wave has grown recently in the member states of the European Union, which is being managed differently in every country. The main goal of the project is to investigate how small towns similar to ours (in regards of location and population) could take advantage of the situation rather than seeing it as a problem. Statistical evidence shows that only 10% of the immigrants find a job immediately. The main reasons for this are the lack of language skills, work experience, and qualifications. By acquiring these skills, the level of employment could be raised to 50% in 5 years and 70% in 15 years. The main tasks and objectives of the European Union today are discussing these common issues, shortening the time frames, utilising the qualifications of the immigrants, and harmonizing the cohabitation of the local



	population and the immigrants. These are the areas where we would like to gain experience and share ours with others. This is what the European Union is about.
