There is no widely-known alternative to throwing any item –even in perfect state– to the waste management or abandoned in the streets (which is forbidden). Resucitadero aims to fill this gap and provide a solid, reliable network to manage the goods that citizens do not want anymore but still have a potentially wide lifespan. It is a space where to gather, classify, store, repair, clean, refurbish, test and sell goods that otherwise would have ended up in a landfill. As a non-profit association, the final prices are strictly set up accordingly to the work accomplished.</i></p> <p><i>We spent some years practicing the lifestyle of dumpster diving, rescuing goods and materials to give them a second life (if not more). We have experience collecting in the streets, repairing and upcycling in the workshop. We have developed the ability to spot and pick potential rescuable items.</i></p>
